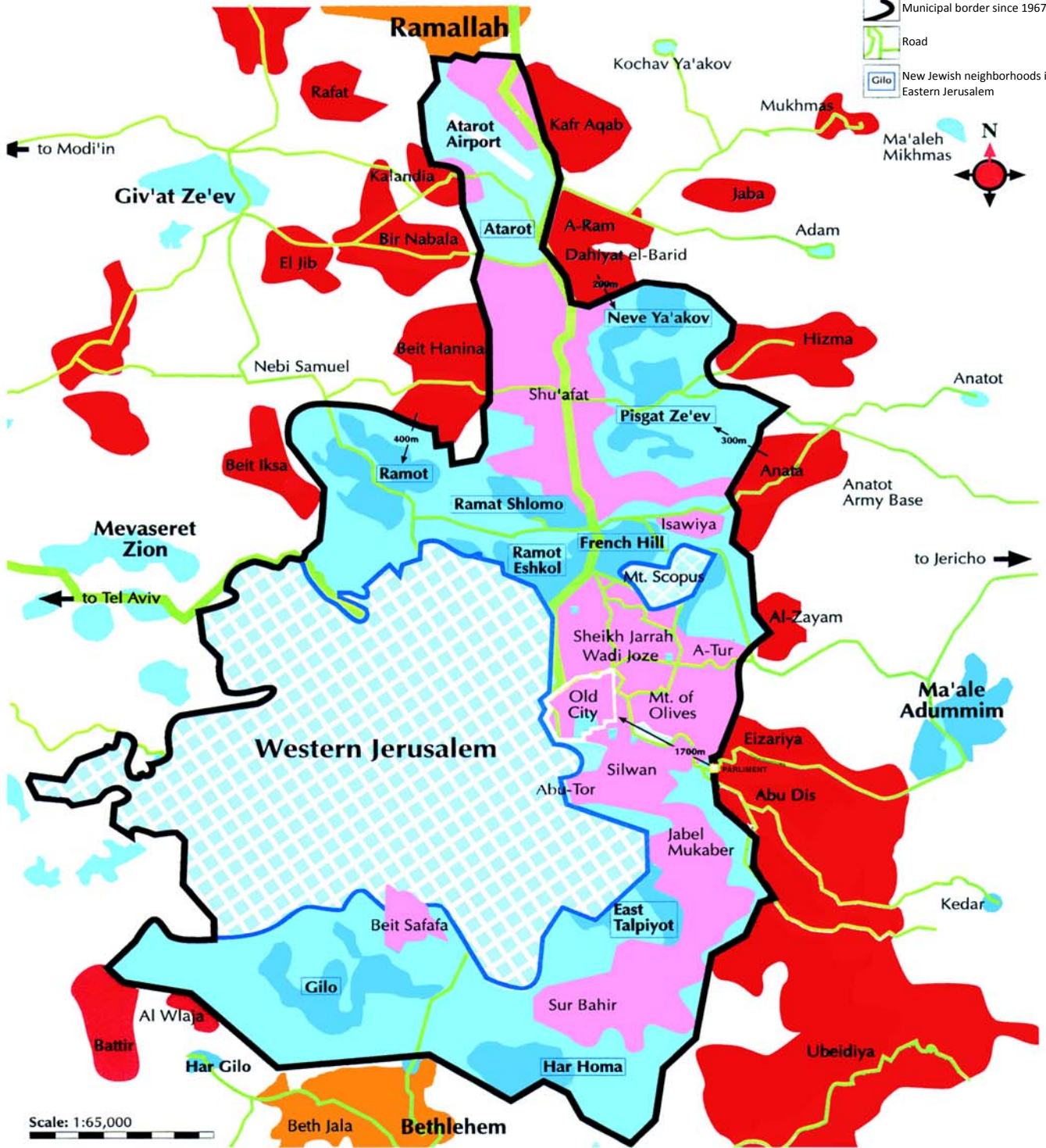


Jerusalem Political Map

According to the Oslo Accords, the areas in red, which surround Jerusalem on three sides are "Area B" under Palestinian civilian control and Israeli military control. The orange areas (Ramallah and Bethlehém) are "Area A" under full Palestinian military and civilian control. If the intent of Oslo is implemented, as attempted by the Olmert Government, Jerusalem will be almost completely surrounded by a hostile Palestinian state. Additionally, according to

the Camp David 2000 and Annapolis 2007 discussions, Arab neighborhoods in Jerusalem (shown in purple) would come under Palestinian sovereignty. Large Jewish neighborhoods would become enclaves and dangerously exposed to the Palestinian state. The Palestinian Arabs would achieve territorial contiguity from Ramallah in the north to Bethlehém in the south, creating a greater "Al Kuds (Arab name for Jerusalem) and dwarfing Jewish Jerusalem.
